



DRESS CODE POLICY

SCHOOL POLICY

- 1 Children, in Years 1 to 7, attending Samson Primary School are expected to wear school uniform.
- 2 Appropriate footwear will be worn at all times.
- 3 Hats will be worn whenever children are outside the building.

GUIDELINES

- 1 The school uniform may consist of a combination of school; T shirt, tracksuit, skirt, shorts, dress, windcheater, House T shirt.(House T shirts should be worn for Athletic Carnivals or at the direction of the school.)
- 2 Either enclosed shoes, sports-shoes or sandals may be worn. Thongs are not appropriate.
- 3 Exemptions may be given on health, religious or ethnic background reasons or at the Principal's discretion.

N.B. The school uniform is available from the uniform shop.

Footwear

To prevent foot injuries, the wearing of sandals (in summer) and shoes (in winter) is stressed. The wearing of thongs is not acceptable.

Hats

Samson Primary has a policy of 'No Hat, No Play'. Students who are not wearing a hat during recess and lunch breaks will be directed to sit in a shaded area. Standardised school hats (uniform) must be worn. These are available from the Uniform Shop or Administration.

Art Shirt

To protect children's clothing, the wearing of an art shirt is required during all art lessons. Please print your child's name on the shirt.

Jewellery & Make Up

Students should not wear jewellery, or make-up to school. Jewellery can be dangerous, particularly during play, sport and physical education activities. Stud earrings are acceptable. **Clear** nail polish is acceptable.

Tattoos

Children are not to display tattoos while they are at school.

The School Council endorsed this policy in 2009.
